GENERAL STATEMENT OF POSITION:

The Youth Support Worker is responsible for organizing and delivering prevention programs offered to connect youth to community supports and services through youth prevention plans, mandatory education series, elder support and youth prevention activities. The Youth Prevention Team will seek to strengthen traditional skills within youth; leverage family, individual strengths and protective factors, create on-going opportunity for youth to develop and enhance their quality of life.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Equip youth in care and in community with necessary skills and education on social/societal issues impacting their overall well-being
- Improves outcomes of Siksika youth by investing in early interventions through education and prevention services and supports to help youth experience a healthy and successful transition into adulthood.
- Partner and network with local service providers to plan, organize and deliver events and programs effectively and efficiently.
- Opens, closes, and maintains (properly and securely stored) filing systems for related programs/services. Files are developed and maintained consistently following provincial standards.
- Assist in facilitating early intervention/prevention programs implementation, delivery and organizing of programs
- Work one on one with Youth who are requesting our support/services.
- Research and development of proposed early intervention programs
- Assists in gathering stats and documentation of programs delivered for reporting purposes.
- Assist in gathering and preparing information for reports as requested.
- Provide documentation and reporting of programs and clientele.
- Integrate Elder Advisory support into all high-risk youth planning, elder visitation/teachings, ceremonies.
